Alternate Treatment Commissioner

The Circuit Court of St. Louis County is accepting applications for the position of Alternate Treatment Commissioner.

The Court encourages qualified individuals to apply for the position. The qualifications are the same as a Circuit Judge. The applicant must be licensed to practice law in the state, be at least 25 years of age, be a citizen of the United States for at least 10 years, be a qualified voter of this state for at least the last three years and a resident of St. Louis County for at least one year. Article V, Section 21 of the Missouri Constitution.

Applications must be completed and filed with the Human Resources Department no later than 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 17, 2019.

The judge of the Alternative Treatment Court will select the commissioner pursuant to 478.003 RSMo. for a four-year term.
